#### **REMINDERS**

Please remember to update your 30 hour childcare code every 3 months if you receive 30 hours free Government funded childcare.

Please ensure that you have sufficient nappies and wipes at nursery for your child and spare clothes that are clearly labelled with their name.

Children should wear clothes to nursery that you do not mind getting dirty. We provide aprons for messy play but as we encourage children to play outside we can not prevent clothes from becoming dirty or stained.
