- Children are encouraged to play outdoors whenever possible, please ensure you bring your child to nursery in appropriate clothing for all weather types. Due to children getting messy during outdoor play and messy play we encourage parents/carers to only put your child in clothing that you do not mind getting stained or messy
- Ensure your child has a spare set of clothing that are clearly labelled with their name in case of any accidents and a supply of nappies and wipes at nursery
- If someone other than yourself is collecting your child you **MUST** ensure you inform nursery of their name and their relationship to your child. You **MUST** ensure they have the correct unique password. Children will **NOT** be released to any other persons unless parents have informed nursery
- Please inform nursery if any of your contact details change i.e. phone number or address
- A late fee of £1 per minute will be charged to you if you are late to collect your child.  
**Please ensure children are collect by 4:00pm.**
- Please ensure all nursery fees are made on time and your account is up to date. Failure to keep up with payments may result in your place being suspended

## Sun Protection



Summer is approaching and the weather is getting warmer. It is important that we protect our children from sunburn and skin damage by applying sun cream and ensuring they wear appropriate clothing.

Please ensure your child brings a sun hat to nursery to help protect them from the sun.

Please ensure you apply sun cream to your child before bringing them to nursery. Nursery staff will apply sun cream to children throughout the day with permission from parents /carers.


## Headlice

We have been informed that some children in nursery have head lice. This is very common in all nurseries and schools and is easily dealt with. Please can all parents/carers ensure you check your child's hair on a regular basis to prevent the spread of headlice. The easiest way to remove head lice is by wet combing;

- wash hair with ordinary shampoo
- apply lots of conditioner
- comb the whole head of hair, from the roots to the ends using a nit comb

You should do wet combing **today**, and then on days 5, 9 and 13 to catch any newly hatched head lice. Check again that everyone's hair is free of lice on day 17. Please speak with a member of staff if you need any advice and tips on how to treat head lice.
